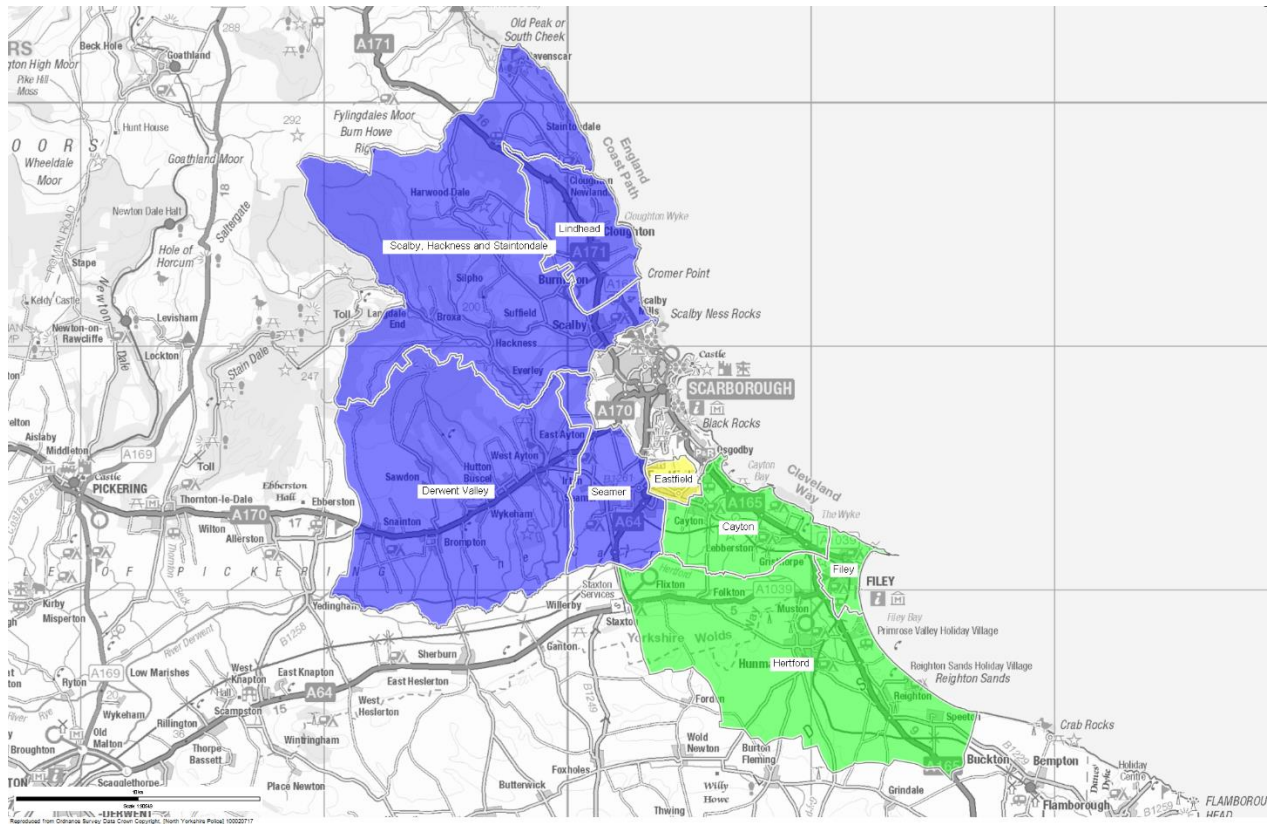

Which areas are covered from Filey and Eastfield Police Stations?

The areas in blue and yellow – covered from Eastfield Police station. Areas in green – covered from Filey Police Station.



There were 182 incidents reported in your area during November. Incidents of note are as follows: -

- 02/11/2023 01:53 – An arson was reported from a flat on Manham Hill. CID are currently investigating this incident, there were no serious injuries suffered.
- 03/11/2023 19:09 – A report was received from Overdale of youths firing fireworks at cars. Officers attended within 4 minutes, but no one could be located.
- 05/11/2023 10:33 – A male riding an electric was stopped on the footpath on Glacier Lane. This was seized from the male who was reported for driving offences.
- 11/11/2023 22:19 – A single vehicle RTC was reported at the park and ride roundabout on A165. The driver was reported to have run off. Officers attended and could locate no one, the vehicle was recovered to await the owner getting in touch.
- 14/11/2023 14:23 – An off-road motor bike failed to stop for Officers on Overdale. It was last seen being ridden by a large youth heading on to Wheatfield Court. The bike had orange sides to it, please report any information and quote 12230216760.

In addition to the crime stats, we also have access to data to show how many total incidents and crimes your local Officers have attended. The below figures are for all Parishes/Towns covered by Filey and Eastfield Police Station and includes ALL incidents and crimes.

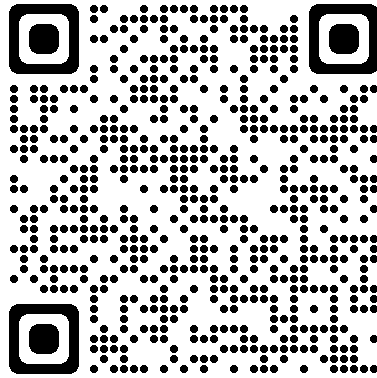
