

Which areas are covered from Filey and Eastfield Police Stations?

The areas in blue and yellow – covered from Eastfield Police station. Areas in green – covered from Filey Police Station.



There were 200 incidents reported in your area during March. Incidents of note are as follows: -

03/03/2024 13:40 – A report was received that an off-road bike was seen to ride over Westway and into The Dell. It was then spotted by Officers in Scarborough but lost on a side street in South Cliff. Please continue to report any incidences such as this, especially if you know who is riding the bikes and where they are being stored.

04/03/2024 10:04 — Officers carried out a drugs warrant at a property on Caymer Road. Two people were arrested on suspicion of drug supply offences after a large quantity of drugs were located. They were bailed to return back to the Police station to allow further investigation.

07/03/2024 16:37 – A vehicle vs motorbike RTC occurred on the junction of Cayton Low Road and Thornborough Road. The rider of the bike suffered minor injuries.

09/03/2024 15:37 — A purse theft was reported by an elderly lady at Morrisons. She discovered her purse missing when she came to pay for items, it is strongly suspected she was distracted whilst shopping allowing the thieves to steal her purse. Suspects have been identified elsewhere in the country and efforts are being made to arrest them. They are circulated as wanted people on the national system.

17/03/2024 00:07 – A vehicle was stopped by Officers on patrol at Musham Bank roundabout. Enquiries reveal there was no insurance in place for the vehicle, so it was seized and the driver reported for this offence.

21/03/2024 16:23 – A resident received a call stating there had been a high value bank transaction from their account and they should press 1 to resolve the matter. Crucially, the call showed as though it was coming from a local 01723 number. **THIS IS A SCAM, there are no banking fraud departments in Scarborough.** Fraudsters can "spoof" local phone numbers so on your caller ID it appears as though they are local, when in fact they are operating from abroad. Please see this link for full details Number spoofing scams - Ofcom. If you are at all doubtful, even if you think it may be genuine but are not 100% certain, then put the phone down and recontact your bank on their normal number or via your banking app. Or visit your local branch if you can find one.

23/03/2024 08:59 — A drugs warrant was carried out at a property on Sweetbecks Close. A large quantity of drugs were found and three people were arrested for drug supply offences. They were later interviewed and released for further investigation to take place.

Community Speedwatch


