

Which areas are covered from Filey and Eastfield Police Stations?

The areas in blue and yellow – covered from Eastfield Police station. Areas in green – covered from Filey Police Station.



There were 292 incidents reported in your area during May. Incidents of note are as follows: - 02/05/2024 12:00 – A resident received a scam call from a criminal purporting to be from the BT technical department. The criminal told the resident that BT had received a notification that their iPad was not secure, they then stated they would put the resident on to google and asked them to type for help on their iPad. Several different pop ups then appeared on the screen. The scammer then tried taking the resident through various steps disguised as being helpful but actually attempting to steal various pieces of identity. Thankfully, the resident was alert to what they did and hung the phone up before contacting their banks to alert them to what had occurred. No financial loss occurred thanks to the vigilance of the resident and then taking the correct steps of hanging up and then contacting your bank.

04/05/2024 12:01 – A vehicle parked on Kempley Drive in Eastfield was damaged two nights in a row by an unknown person/s. An investigation is being carried out with a couple of lines of enquiry under way. Please report any information and quote incident 12240078595.

06/05/2024 10:29 – A high value burglary of a business on Olympian Trading Estate was reported. 9 custom made electrical bikes worth a total of £43,100 were stolen overnight. Images of the stolen bikes can be found on this link, they are the only bikes of this type in existence and have nevber

07/05/2024 19:18 – A youth known to Officers was seen riding an off-road motor bike on Dale Edge. He was interviewed by Officers for a number of offences and will be referred for diversionary work to hopefully prevent a reoccurrence.

13/05/2024 19:40 – A fail to stop RTC was reported to have occurred two days previously on 11/05/24 on High Garth, a Ford Kuga was struck by an unknown vehicle at about 0730hrs causing extensive damage down the passenger side. Please report any information and quote incident 12240084081.

15/05/2024 13:56 – A some point between 10/05 and 13/05, the glass in the front door of a house on Sandstone Road was found to be damaged. It was possibly caused by an air rifle but this isn't confirmed. Please report any similar incidents in this area.

17/05/2024 16:25 – Damage was caused to the rubber matting on the floor of the playground on Malling Avenue. Details were passed to local PCSOs to include this on their area of patrol.

19/05/2024 15:25 – A male was arrested on suspicion of assaulting an emergency after he allegedly spat on a Police Officer dealing with an incident. He was later charged with this same offence and will appear at court in June.

19/05/2024 23:23 – The kitchen window of a house on Kempley Drive was damaged by someone hitting it with an unknown object.
