

# Which areas are covered from Filey and Eastfield Police Stations?

The areas in blue and yellow – covered from Eastfield Police station. Areas in green – covered from Filey Police Station.



There were 191 incidents reported in your area during September. Incidents of note are as follows: -

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Cohort of Mini Police began last week at Overdale School. This event is kindly supported by Eastfield Town Council. Please contact PCSO Jake Fairbotham should you require more information. Jake is also looking for volunteers to assist, particularly with the upcoming mock court case.

01/09/2024 19:35 – An off-road motor bike was seized from a 14-year-old youth by Officers on patrol on Dale Edge. He was reported for driving offences so now it is likely that when he obtains his first driving license age 17 it will automatically have points on it. This will also likely inflate his insurance premiums to a very high-level making driving almost unaffordable.

12/09/2024 – Response and Neighbourhood Police Officers from Eastfield Police Station attended a reported hanging person at a property. Through the Officers swift response, forced entry to the house and CPR, the person's life was saved. They are now receiving care and support. The number for Samaritans is **116 123.** There are other options to speak to people on their website Contact Us Samaritans

14/09/2024 23:00 – Officers were called to a verbal dispute on Burnside. After a stop & search, one male was arrested for possession of Class B drugs.

16/09/2024 19:24 – A vehicle parked on Link Walk was reported to have its windscreen smashed at some point over the last few hours. There are currently no suspects. Please report any information and guote 12240169173.

19/09/2024 20:47 – A drunk male in possession of a Henry vacuum cleaner was found asleep in a bush up the side of Morrisons. Upon waking, he was very unpleasant to Officers and putting himself in danger near moving traffic so was arrested on suspicion of being drunk and disorderly in a public place. He was later charged with the same offence and will appear at court in October. The involvement in this incident of H\*nry the vacuum cleaner remains unclear, so his name has been redacted to protect his anonymity.

22/09/2024 – Overnight, motor bikes were reported to have been stolen from The Leas and The Meads in Eastfield, both bikes were recovered nearby. These offences are under investigation, please report any information and quote 12240173127.

23/09/2024 02:15 – Damage was caused to the wing mirror of a car parked on Herdborough Road. A person is seen on CCTV punching the wing mirror. Please report any information and quote 12240173689.

26/09/2024 – Another drugs warrant was carried out at a property on Westway, the third at this property this year. A male and female were arrested, both were charged with 10 offences relating to drug supply in the local area.

27/09/2024 18:51 – A vehicle was stopped by Officers on patrol on Dunslow Road. The driver failed a roadside breath test so was arrested on suspicion of drink driving. He was later charged with the same offence and will appear at court later in October.
