

# Which areas are covered from Filey and Eastfield Police Stations?

The areas in blue and yellow – covered from Eastfield Police station. Areas in green – covered from Filey Police Station.



There were 179 incidents reported in your area during December. Incidents of note are as follows: -

07/12/24 & 08/12/24 – There was widespread disruption across the roads throughout the weekend. Multiple trees succumbed to the wind, blocking roads in the process. A recovery truck attended one location to pick a car up that had struck a fallen tree, a tree then fell down on the access route which blocked the recovery truck in.

11/12/2024 05:57 – Two motorbikes were stolen in Eastfield overnight. Both were located nearby and the crimes are under investigation.

11/12/2024 14:46 – A vehicle first seen at Musham Bank was stopped in town a short while after. The driver was issued with traffic offence reports for having a defective light and defective tyre.

12/12/2024 01:48 – A male was arrested at Musham Bank for being drunk whilst driving a mobility scooter. He was later charged with being drunk in charge of a carriage under the Licensing Act 1872.

13/12/2024 16:42 – An unregistered off-road motorbike failed to stop for Officers on Cayton Low Road. It was followed by traffic Police but lost into the Dell off Overdale. The tracks were followed and it was located on High Garth where it failed to stop again. Please report any information relating to off-road bikes. We do seize them and deal with the riders for offences when we catch them.

14/12/2024 10:33 – An off-road bike made off from a PCSO into the Dell. The PCSO was able to identify the youth who was riding it, they have been spoken to with their parents and will be prosecuted for driving without a license and no insurance.
