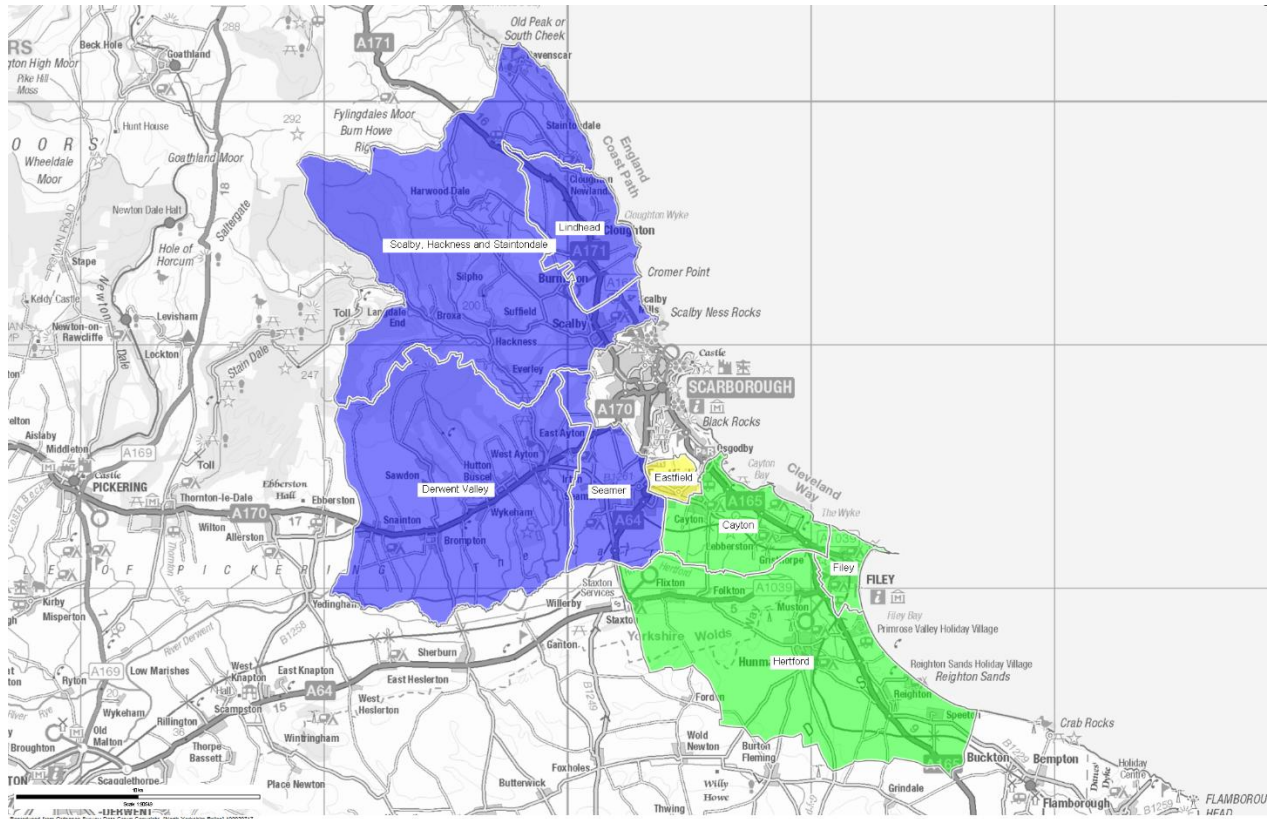

Which areas are covered from Filey and Eastfield Police Stations?

The areas in blue and yellow – covered from Eastfield Police station. Areas in green – covered from Filey Police Station.



There were 233 incidents reported in your area during April. Incidents of note are as follows: -

01/04/2025 16:46 – A small child ran out from behind a parked car on Lodgers Green and was hit by a car. Thankfully, the car was travelling at low speed and the child only suffered bumps and scrapes. The driver was not at fault and could not have avoided the child.

02/04/2025 19:30 – A mountain bike was reported to have been stolen from a garden on Herdborough Way. The victim made their own enquiries resulting in the bike being returned. There are presently no lines of enquiry to trace a suspect but should we receive information on who stole the bike then action can still be taken. Please report any information and quote 12250058339.

09/04/2025 13:21 – A black off-road bike made off from Officers on High Garth. Please continue to report off-road bikes being used in Eastfield.

11/04/2025 15:26 – A motorbike was stopped by Officers in The Dell in Eastfield. Enquiries revealed the bike to be stolen to the rider was arrested on suspicion of theft. Due to the smell of alcohol, the

rider was breath tested, the result of which was over twice the legal limit. He was arrested and later charged with - Take a motor vehicle without the owner's consent, driving a motor vehicle whilst over the prescribed limit of alcohol, driving a motor vehicle without a valid policy of motor insurance covering third party risk and drive other than in accordance with a licence.

12/04/2025 16:22 – A drunk male was reported to be acting in a disorderly manner in a field off Cayton Low Road. Officers attended and arrested the male for being drunk and disorderly. He later received an out of court disposal whilst in Scarborough custody with a condition attached that he address his drinking.

15/04/2025 07:40 – A black Peugeot moped was stolen from the flats on Pindar Road at some point during the previous night. Enquiries are ongoing to locate the bike and potential suspects. Please report any information and quote 12250066514.

15/04/2025 15:00 – A report was received from a member of the public of an orange KTM motorbike being dumped in The Dell. Officers attended and locate the bike. The owner also attended and confirmed it had been stolen this same morning. Please report any information and quote 12250066765.

19/04/2025 22:05 – A large disturbance with weapons was reported on Caymer Road. Officers attended and have so far arrested 6 people. Although there were no serious injuries, the circumstances dictate that this is being treated as a serious incident with CID currently under taking a number of investigative actions. Please report any information and quote 12250069516.

23/04/2025 20:41 – A large disturbance was reported on High Moor Way. Officers attended and initially arrested 2 females. 3 other people have been arrested since and the incident remains under investigation.

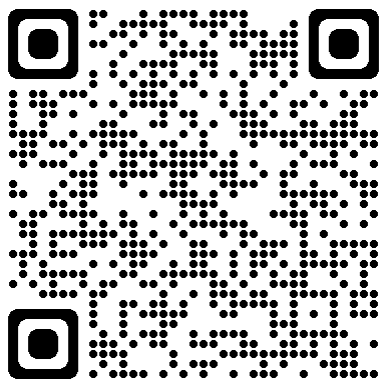

Enquiries led to 3 people being arrested on suspicion of arson with intent to endanger life. They were later bailed for further enquires to take place.
