

Which areas are covered from Filey and Eastfield Police Stations?

The areas in blue and yellow – covered from Eastfield Police station. Areas in green – covered from Filey Police Station.



There were 251 incidents reported in your area during May. Incidents of note are as follows: -

02/05/2025 08:27 – Two motor bikes were stolen from a garden on Station Road in Crossgates. One was burnt out next to the house, the other was found on Musham Bank Road with damage to the ignition wiring. The investigation is ongoing, please report any information and quote 12250077718.

07/05/2025 00:03 – A vehicle failed to stop for Officers in Crossgates and was pursued around the Seamer, Flixton and Muston area before hitting a kerb near Muston and losing a tyre. The driver escaped on foot but enquiries are ongoing to trace him, the vehicle was later reported stolen. Please report any information and quote 12250081018.

12/05/2025 21:25 – A vehicle was stopped by Officers on Cayton Low Road. Enquiries revealed there was no insurance on the vehicle so it was seized. The driver refused to hand over the car keys and walked off so the car was dragged onto the recovery truck and he was reported for no insurance.

11/05/2025 01:18 – This is not an Eastfield incident but is relevant to the whole area. A vigilant resident in Seamer reported youths trying car door handles on Main Street. Officers attended but no suspects were located. There were no vehicles reported to have been broken into that night. Please see below community message which was sent out the next day

We have had a report of vehicle interference in your area, please keep security in mind. You can make it much harder for offenders to target your vehicle by:

- Removing tools overnight where possible or hiding them out of sight
- Adding internal security such as tool lockers or improved door locks
- Fitting a vehicle alarm and tracker
- Fitting a dash cam
- Parking in front of CCTV or a video doorbell where possible
- Parking on a driveway with rear doors up against a solid object
