

There were 288 incidents reported in your area during June. Incidents of note are as follows: -

05/06/2025 11:24 – Two drugs warrants were carried out at separate addresses in Eastfield, on Beech Walk and Ridgeway. Three males were arrested, Class A & B drugs recovered, along with cash and several digital devices seized for examination. Please continue to report any intelligence. We will act on information received.

12/06/2025 08:08 – A wing mirror was snapped off a Hyundai GETZ in yellow parked on Burnside whilst the owner was working a nightshift nearby. Please report any information and quote 12250105726.

12/06/2025 13:56 – Officers on patrol carry out enquiries on a scooter whilst on High Street in Eastfield. These enquiries revealed no tax or MOT. Upon being informed his bike would be seized, the rider made an unconventional decision to kick his own bike over before putting his keys down a drain. Nonetheless, the bike was seized and rider reported.

21/06/2025 13:18 – Due to numerous youths engaging in ASB on High Street and the surrounding area, a dispersal order was requested by local Officers and authorised by an Inspector. The dispersal order was issued until 2359hrs 22/06/25 and there were no significant issues whilst it was in place.

30/06/2025 09:00 - Officers from the Neighbourhood Policing Team carried out a drugs warrant at a property in Eastfield. One person was arrested on suspicion of possession with intent to supply drugs. Drugs, money and phones were seized.
