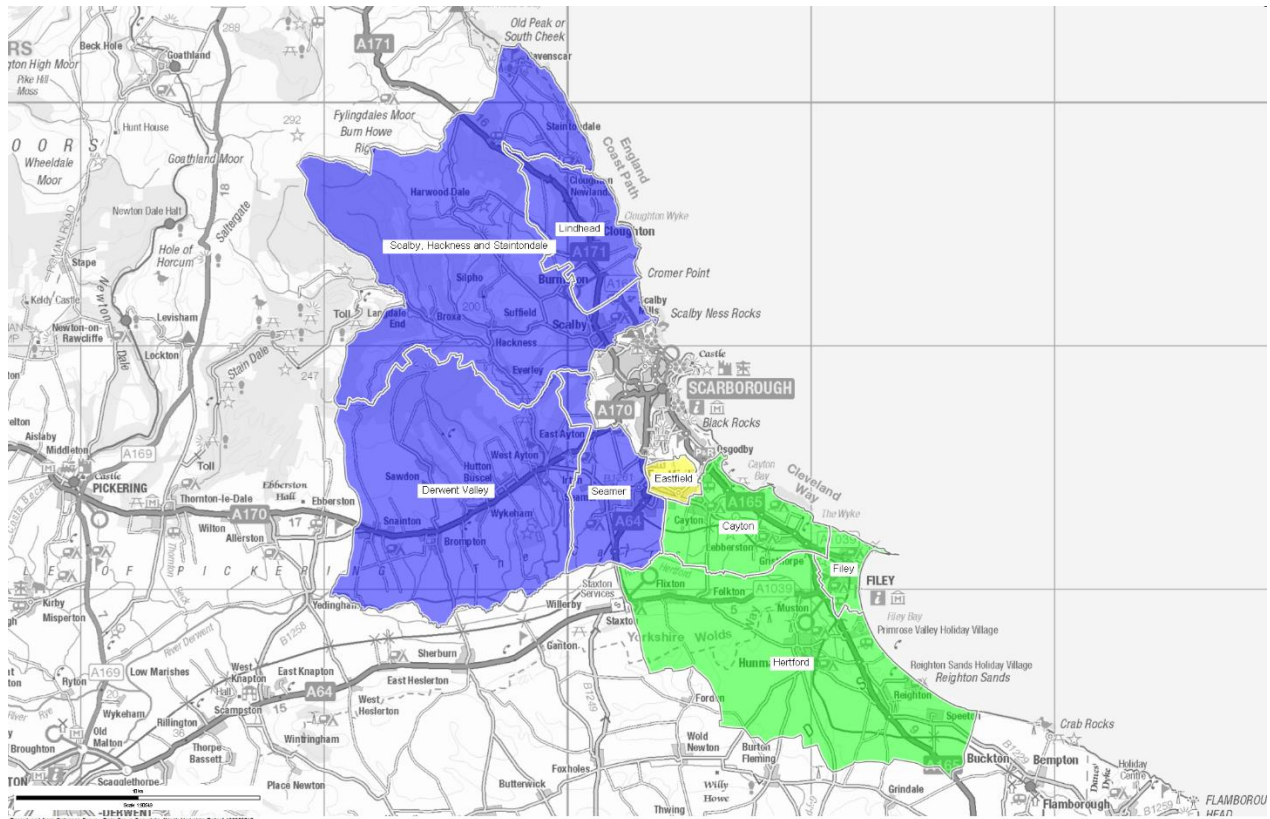

Which areas are covered from Filey and Eastfield Police Stations?

The areas in blue and yellow – covered from Eastfield Police station. Areas in green – covered from Filey Police Station.



There were 260 incidents reported in your area during September. Incidents of note are as follows: -

10/09/2025 19:32 – Two 15-year-old youths were issued with dispersal notices to leave the High Street area of Eastfield for 24 hours. There were no breaches of this reported and no ASB reported after they were dispersed.

12/09/2025 21:17 – A large disturbance was reported during a funeral wake at Eastfield Sports & Social Club on Eastway. Officers attended and quelled the disorder without the need for mass arrests at what was an emotional time for everyone involved.

15/09/2025 14:01 – A group of young children climbed over the fence and caused damage at the rear of Eastfield Library. They have all been identified by PCSOs and preventative work will be carried out to help prevent future occurrences.

21/09/2025 09:27 – Numerous members of the public reported concern for a drunk male who had driven into the side of KFC near Morrisons. Officers located the vehicle on Westway in Eastfield. The driver failed a roadside breath test, providing a reading of double the legal limit. The vehicle was recovered and the driver later charged with drink driving.

22/09/2025 15:24 – A female failed to appear at court after being charged with Obstructing Police and committing an offence under the Public Order Act on 03/09/25. She was located in Eastfield on 23/09/25, arrested and remanded to court the next day where she received a fine.

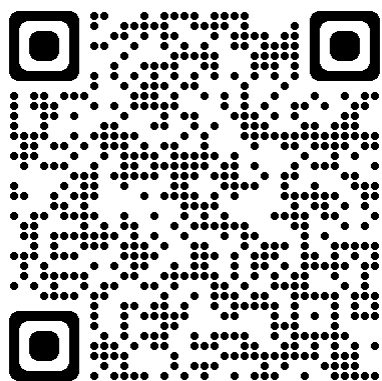
26/09/2025 05:57 – A burglary was reported to have occurred at about 0520hrs at a commercial premises on Cayton Low Road. Approximately £3,500 of copper was stolen by suspects who were driving a dark coloured Peugeot car. The incident is under investigation, please report any information and quote 12250182022.
