

Which areas are covered from Filey and Eastfield Police Stations?

There were 306 incidents reported in your area during October. Incidents of note are as follows: -

10/10/2025 00:46 – A report was received that a vehicle parked on Dunn Grove had had a window smashed. It is suspected this was a targeted attack rather than mindless vandalism, so far 3 people have been arrested and the incident remains under investigation. 11/10/2025 21:52 – A disturbance in the street was reported from a 16th birthday party on Fox Way in Eastfield. Officers attended and calmed the situation down; the party ended shortly after our attendance.

13/10/2025 01:43 — A wanted male was arrested after being seen on Caymer Road in Eastfield. He was wanted for failing to attend York Crown Court for 3 drug supply offences from a warrant executed in Eastfield during 2024.

14/10/2025 09:13 – Two vehicles parked on Link Walk were damaged overnight in what appeared to be attempts to break into them. Please report any information and quote 12250194183.

28/10/2025 13:48 – Numerous reports were received about fireworks being set off and thrown on High Street in Eastfield. Officers attended and put in place a dispersal order for the area for 24 hours. If any of the people involved return to the area within 24 hours, they can be arrested.
