

Which areas are covered from Filey and Eastfield Police Stations?

The areas in blue and yellow – covered from Eastfield Police station. Areas in green – covered from Filey Police Station.



There were 258 incidents reported in your area during November. Incidents of note are as follows: -

07/11/2025 15:05 – A green and black coloured off-road bike was stolen on Holme Hill whilst it was being ridden by its young owner. Enquiries are ongoing into this incident.

18/11/2025 12:02 — Officers searching for a wanted male at an address on High Garth located a quantity of cannabis in a room, the male was not present. When located, the male will be dealt with for possessing this cannabis.

20/11/2025 – Officers attended numerous RTCs and stranded vehicles across the area due to the snow and ice. Numerous reports were also received about youths throwing snow and ice at houses.

21/11/2025 10:07 – A driver was stopped by Officers on patrol on Moor Lane in Eastfield. They were reported for allegedly using a mobile phone whilst driving.

22/11/2025 13:17 – A red Vauxhall Corsa failed to stop for Officers on patrol on Westway. It was located a short while later with no occupants further up Westway. The vehicle was seized by Police and enquiries are ongoing to locate the driver.

22/11/2025 – Four incidents were reported in quick succession between 1630hrs and 1846hrs, a shed burglary and theft from a car on Ouzle Grove, a shed burglary on Fox Way and a theft from a garden on Westway. Officers attended the area and arrested a male on suspicion of committing all four offences. To allow investigation of further offences, he was bailed until January with a nighttime curfew and conditions not to enter Eastfield.
