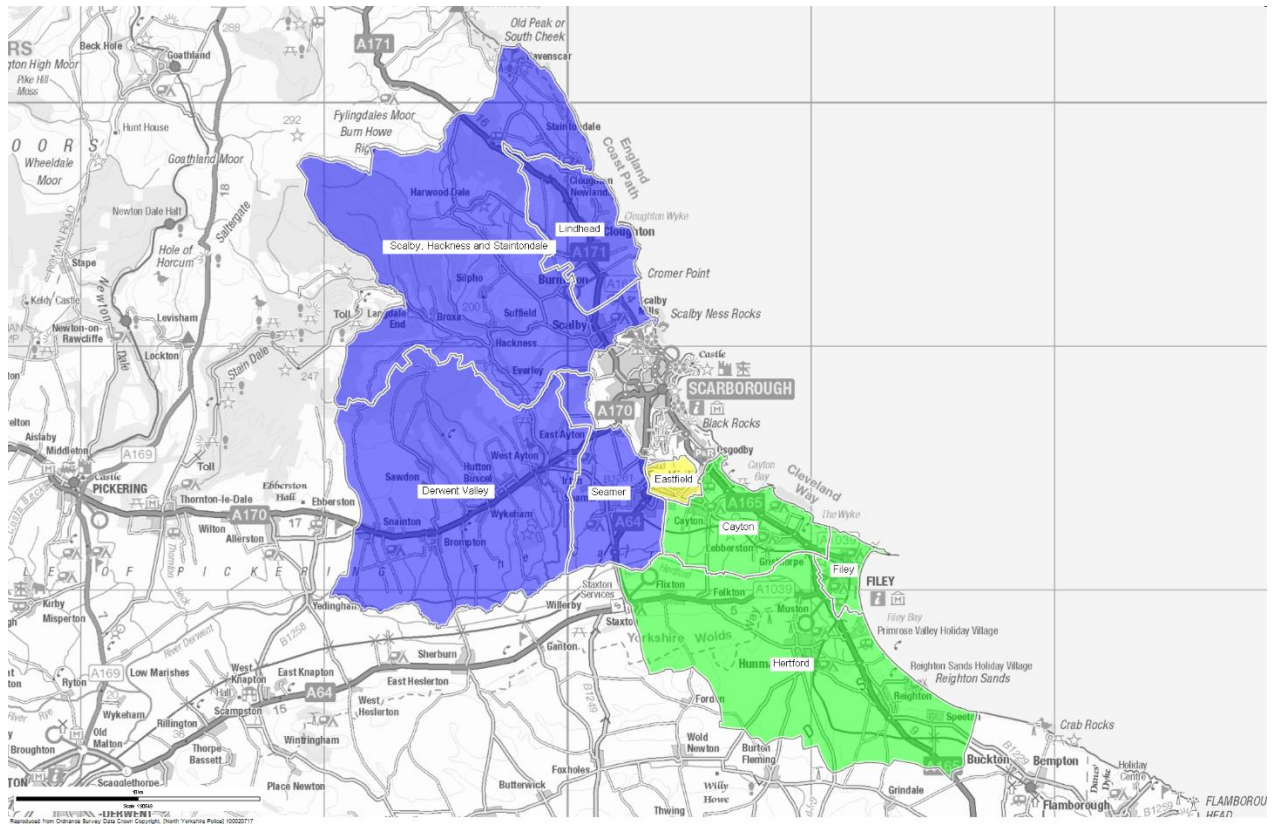

The areas in blue and yellow – covered from Eastfield Police station. Areas in green – covered from Filey Police Station.



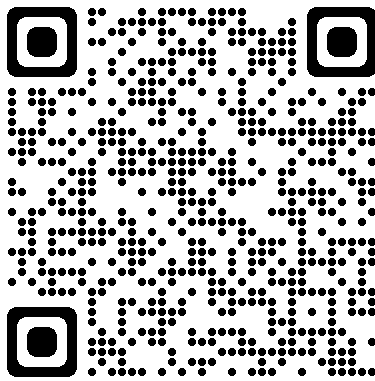
There were **239** incidents reported in your area during December.
